

# RCS SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Students are required to wear uniforms while attending school. Exceptions will be made for \* 'Free Dress Day' which will be the last Friday of the month unless changed. The school normally promotes a T-shirt, sweatshirt type shirt sale (with the school logo) during the school year.

The items on the chart are approved for students of RCS. This dress code covers all acceptable clothing items at RCS. Any clothing item not addressed in this uniform policy is considered unacceptable by the administrator and the church board and may not be worn to school or school functions.

\*Facial make-up for girls should not be conspicuous or draw attention to the student. Girls may wear ear jewelry which is in good taste and does not draw attention to the student. Tattoos, removable or permanent, are inappropriate and not allowed.

\*Body jewelry other than the above mentioned is unacceptable. This does not include watches, bracelets, necklaces and similar items that do not draw attention to the student.

\*Uniform shorts must come within 4 inches of the knee. Shorts should be uniform shorts. Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in.

\*Clothing on 'Free Dress Day' will not include words or visuals which denote alcohol, tobacco or profanity in any form or draw attention to any part of the human body. Bare mid-riff, sleeveless shirts or see through mesh is never allowed.

\*Clothing should reflect the Christian environment RCS strives to maintain.

\*Pants must be worn at the waist.
